**Group Change:** When a swimmer moves from one group to another, requirements of the new group being on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the next full month (applies to dues, enrichment and fundraising/contribution requirements).

*Swimmers moving up from Stroke School or Novice will meet with their current coach and/or team representative to determine team requirements and obligations of the group moved to.*

## Fundraising/Contribution:

- 1.) **Fundraising/Contribution:** Fundraising and contribution obligations will be based on an annual rate payable over twelve months from September through August. Fundraising fees are payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month with dues payments. Annual obligations will be:

Fundraising activities will be held throughout the year. Support of these activities is encouraged to keep dues at current levels.

- 2.) **Albertson's:** Community Partners with Albertson's is not a requirement, but we encourage all members to shop at Albertson's. The team will issue an Albertson's donation card to you upon your request. A percentage of your shopping dollars spent at Albertson's is donated to the team.

## Team Out-fitting:

- 1.) **Speedo Sports Commitment:** Speedo is a team sponsor, and our commitment to Speedo is our assurance that members of our team use Speedo products whenever possible.
- 2.) **Swimsuits:** At all competitions, designated team suits must be worn.
- 3.) **T-Shirts:** All members will be required to purchase three team shirts at the beginning of the team year. Order forms are available at registration. After that time, shirts can be purchased through the team store. It is recommended that all members wear a team shirt at competitions.
- 4.) **Warm-Ups:** Warm-ups are required only for the National, JO 1, 2, & 3 Groups, but are recommended for all members. If a member would like to order warm-ups, please see our team dealer.
- 5.) **Team Swim Caps:** If a swimmer wears a cap for competition, it must be the designated team cap. If a member does not have a team cap, please see your coach. Team caps will be available at all competitions. A \$5.00 per charge for latex cap will be added to your account payable with the next month's dues. Custom caps with swimmer names will be ordered 3 times a year (Sept, Dec, and April)

## Practice:

- 1.) **Closed Practice Sessions:** All practice sessions, unless otherwise noted, are considered closed. It is required that parents/guardians keep a distance from the swimmers and Coaches during practices. Swimmers and Coaches are not able to see or communicate with anyone unless an emergency. We ask that swimmers and coaches not be interrupted during practice.
- 2.) **Dropping off and Picking up:** All members may drop off swimmers to the pool 10 minutes before and pick-up no later than 10 minutes after each scheduled practice. If you are unable to meet the drop off and pick up requirements, please make arrangements with your parent representative or coach. The team is not responsible supervision of your child before or after these times.
- 3.) **Equipment:** Each group has a list of required equipment for practice purposes. Required equipment is important to the progress of each swimmer. If a member does not have or has lost required equipment, please see our team dealer.
- 4.) **Team File Boxes:** Each family has a file in the team file boxes located on the pool deck. It is your responsibility to check it often for team information and communication.

## Swim Meets:

- 1.) **New members:** New Members joining after September 1 will be responsible for a prorated number of service hours after 120 days of membership, beginning with the swimmer's first day of practice. If the swimmer competes in more than one meet during the 120 days, you are responsible for **two volunteer hours per session** after the swimmer's first meet.
- 2.) **Stroke School/Novice:** Members of these group; your help will be appreciated, but is not required if your swimmers are not participating in a swim meet. **Two hours per session will be required** if your swimmers are participating.
- 3.) **Timing:** At meets hosted by other teams, families will be required to volunteer with timing based on the number of families at the meet and the number of chairs our team is expected to fill. Families who do not meet the requirements will be assessed a \$10.00 fee per session. It is your responsibility to sign up for your timing shift. Your timing commitment is in addition to your family volunteer hours.
- 4.) **Deck Fees:** All swimmers attending meets outside the Las Vegas, Henderson, and Boulder City areas will incur a \$30.00 deck fee for out-of-town meets. Families with two or more swimmers attending the meet will incur a \$45.00 max fee for out-of-town meets. The deck fees will be applied to the coaches' travel costs. Deck fees are to be included with meet entry fees and paid in advance of travel.
- 5.) **Meet Schedules:** A meet schedule is established by the coaches with the expectation that swimmers will attend every meet available at their level. Coaches enter swimmers in all appropriate meets. Intent not to swim must be given to the coach by the decline date posted. *Families are responsible to pay all entry fees in which their swimmer(s) has been entered and for which decline has not been given by the appropriate date.* **Team championship meets, like the Junior Olympics and NV State, are important to the Sandpipers, and Sandpiper swimmers who qualify are expected to attend and contribute to the total team effort.** At every meet it is important for swimmers to check with their coach before leaving a meet to see if they have been placed on a relay for which they need to stay and swim.
- 6.) **Volunteer Hours/Fees:** Each Family will be responsible to work a minimum of 36 service hours per membership year. Additional hours may be required for special events. Meet volunteers must "sign in" and "sign out" on the volunteer meet lists to receive credit for total hours. Other event volunteer hours are documented on submitted green *Happy to Help* cards. Uncompleted hours at the end of each season will be billed at \$10 per hour. *Any member unable to volunteer hours may choose the Volunteer "OPT OUT" Plan by paying \$250.00 non-refundable fee every six months. 1<sup>st</sup> due September, 2<sup>nd</sup> due March.*
- 7.) **Donations:** Donations are requested for each hosted meet. Hosted swim meets are important fundraisers for our team; support of these meets is necessary for us to meet our budgetary goals each year. One of the following is required from each family per hosted meet: 2 Cases Coda (Pepsi or Coke products ONLY) OR 2 Cases Water OR 1 Case Gatorade  
(OR other item(s) as specified by Concession or Hospitality Directors)

## Other:

**Team Registration:** All new members will be charged a \$50.00 registration fee per family. Any member leaving the team and not paying dues for one month or more during the previous 12 months will be charged a re-registration of \$50 upon returning to the team. (New try out may be required for returning member.)

**USA Swimming Registration:** All swimmers are required to register with USA Swimming through Southern California Swimming within 30 days of joining the team. Serious fines and penalties can apply to the team, and swimmer(s) may not practice or compete in meets if registration is not complete. If you do not have this registration form, please see your coach. Birth certificate is required to verify date of birth.

## Membership Agreement:

I, \_\_\_\_\_, understand that the **Clark County Sandpipers of Nevada** is a **non-profit, parent-run organization**. The team operates on monthly dues and fundraising activities. I understand that I will be asked to contribute time and/or money to support the team. I also understand that my monthly fees are to be paid by the first of each month and are considered late by the 10<sup>th</sup> of that month. If dues are not paid by the 10<sup>th</sup>, there will be a 10% late fee attached to the regular monthly dues. I understand that if the dues are not paid by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the following month (45 days), my swimmers(s) may not be allowed to practice or attend meets. Fees are to be paid every month. If a swimmer takes a month or more leave from the team, he/she will be required to pay the team registration and any outstanding obligations from the previous membership agreement to reinstate the swimmer's membership (provided space availability). A team try-out may be necessary for appropriate group placement.
